FAQ

What is Interlibrary Loan?

Interlibrary loan (ILL) Interlibrary loan is the process by which a library requests materials from, or supplies materials to, another library. The purpose of interlibrary loan is to obtain, upon request of a library user, materials not available in the user's local library (National Interlibrary Loan Code for the United States).

What is ILLiad?

ILLiad is a software product that allows you to electronically request material from other libraries. It tracks the process through your email account.

Requesting an Interlibrary Loan with ILLiad

When you see the icon, use your herkimer.edu username and password to log in to ILLiad. The user name and password will be the same as you use to access your username@herkimer.edu email account. If you are a first-time user, you must register only once before you can request items. You will NOT have to repeat this information again. In other words, you will not have to do this when you need items in the future.

Material usually <u>AVAILABLE</u> through Interlibrary loan

- Any material found in libraries is generally available.
- Books, government documents, theses, music, and some videos, depending on other library lending policies.
- Materials produced in microform.

Material Usually NOT Available

- Course textbooks
- Periodical volumes
- Recent newspapers
- Bulky or fragile items
- Reference books
- Rare or valuable material such as manuscripts
