Full Sessions (20-30 Minutes) Include:

- Introduction and demo of searching the Catalog
 - ⇒ Books and other on campus items. Locating them in the building
 - ⇒ Electronic Books
- Introduction and demo of Databases
 - ⇒ Explanation of what a database is and why to use one (or more)
 - ⇒ Explanation of how to select appropriate databases
 - ⇒ Demo of two different databases
 If the professor has specific ones in mind those will certainly be shown
- Throughout the session Interlibrary Loan is discussed at the appropriate times
 - ⇒ in terms of ordering Books and Journal Articles
 - Keywords and search terms are woven into the discussion
- Searching the internet and advanced search techniques
- **Citations** (and a brief plagiarism discussion, if desired)

Brief Sessions (10-15 Minutes) Include:

- Introduction and Demo of one or two of the following:
 - ⇒ Catalog
 - ⇒ Databases
 - ⇒ Searching the Internet
 - ⇒ Citations
 - Interlibrary Loan will always be explained

Interactive Sessions (approx. 40-50 min) Include: (Works best with 12-18 students)

- Brief Introduction and demo of searching the Catalog
- Brief Introduction of the databases
 - ⇒ Explanation of what a database is and why to use one (or more)
 - ⇒ Explanation of how to select appropriate databases
- Students are then divided into groups, assigned either the catalog or a database and then explore their resource by answering a set of questions. Groups are given approx. 15 minutes. They then share with the other groups what they learned.
- During the impromptu presentations the Librarian will add in any important features that may need further explanation such as:
 - ⇒ Keywords, search terms
 - ⇒ Focusing a topic
 - ⇒ Interlibrary loan
 - ⇒ Citations
