Notes for Herkimer County Community College-The College of Saint Rose Social Work Agreement:

- 1) EN 225 and EN 111 combine to come in as ENG 105 (4 credits) and GEL 001 (2 credits of general elective) to complete the L01 requirement.
- 2) Students should avoid taking Statistics to fulfill L07: Mathematical Reasoning, as Statistics is not considered a Liberal Education course
- 3) Students should use 3 credits of Social Science electives to take SS 141 American Government which transfers into Saint Rose as POS 111, a major requirements for the Social Work program at Saint Rose. This course will also fulfill the liberal education requirement L10: Behavioral & Social Sciences 1.
- 4) Successful completion of HS 111 Introduction to Social Science combined with HS 211 and HS 212 Practicum in Human Services I&II, leads a student to take SWK 212 Societies and Social Welfare for 2 credits instead of SWK 213 Social Change and Social Services for 3 credits when she or he transfers into Saint Rose
- 5) Students may wish to pursue a cluster of courses emphasizing family studies, required courses and equivalencies can be found on the next page. Or, students may wish to use the credits to take general electives that will apply toward the 122 credits required to graduate from Saint Rose.
- 6) Students must earn a grade of C or better in every course required for the major taken at The College of Saint Rose.
- 7) The maximum number of transfer credits allowed is 62.
