

TRANSFER OPPORTUNITIES

HCCC has established transfer agreements with four-year colleges and universities to provide a seamless transfer of credits.

The State University of New York has established a transfer policy which guarantees all holders of the A.A. and A.S. degree admission to a four-year unit of the university. Entrance within a particular institution is not guaranteed. Students considering transfer in any of these programs are advised to consult with their advisor and/or transfer counselor for complete information regarding special qualifications or conditions for admission to the receiving institution.

2 + 2 PROGRAMS

In order to provide HCCC graduates with diversified educational opportunities, the College has established a variety of 2 + 2 programs. Students successfully completing a two-year program of study and the associate degree at Herkimer County are assured of admission to specific programs at certain baccalaureate degree granting institutions.

AMERICAN INTERNATIONAL COLLEGE, Springfield, MA

Graduates of the Physical Therapist Assistant (A.A.S.) degree program are eligible to transfer all courses with a grade no lower than a B- and have them applied to a Bachelor of Science degree in Interdepartmental Science leading to a Master's degree in Physical Therapy (M.P.T.). Transfer students will require a total of three and one half years to complete the Master's degree at American International College.

BERKELEY COLLEGE, New York, NY

This agreement stipulates that students from Herkimer County Community College who have completed an Associate Degree with an overall GPA of at least a 2.0 will be accepted into a parallel program outlined below with junior status at Berkeley College.

Students graduating with an A.S. in Business: Business Administration from Herkimer County Community College will be granted full junior status at Canisius College and all credits will be accepted toward the Business curriculum (Richard J. Wehle School of Business). Students must have a cumulative grade point average of 2.0 on a 4.0 scale.

CLARKSON UNIVERSITY, Potsdam, NY

Upon successful completion of the Physical Therapist Assistant (PTA) program with a GPA of 3.0 or higher, students will be able to complete the Bachelor of Professional Studies degree in five consecutive semesters (summer, fall, spring, summer, fall). At the completion of the undergraduate program, students who have met the minimum qualifications for continuation into the Master of Physical Therapy program will begin their graduate coursework. The Master of Physical Therapy program can be completed in an additional seven semesters (spring, summer, fall, spring, summer, fall, spring). Completion of the B.P.S. and M.P.T. degrees, as outlined in this agreement, is based upon successful completion of all required courses in the timeframe provided.
