****Important:** Please read the policies and procedures below to determine your financial aid eligibility for the Winter Mini session.

A. Requirements:

- Student must be matriculated in a degree program at HCCC **prior** to the Winter Mini 2010 session
- Student must be meeting satisfactory academic progress (SAP) requirements at the end of the Fall 2009 semester.
- Students must be registered for both the Winter Mini **and** Spring 2010 semester, for at least a combined 6 credit hours.
- Students must have a valid 2009-2010 FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) on file prior to December 11, 2009.

B. Types of Financial Aid:

- *Federal Pell Grant*
Only those students with additional Pell Grant eligibility will have it automatically applied to their Winter Mini session.
- *Federal Direct Loans*
If a student has additional subsidized or unsubsidized loan eligibility (did not borrow the annual maximum loan amount), they will need to request the loan amount on the reverse side of this form.
- *TAP*
There will be no TAP available for Winter Mini sessions.
- *APTS*
There will be no APTS available for Winter Mini sessions.

C. Disbursements and Refunds:

- Additional financial aid eligibility will be disbursed as part of your **Spring 2010** disbursements. Disbursements will take place during the 5th and 9th weeks of the Spring term. There will be no refunds issued during the Winter Mini session.

D. Important Information:

- There are annual maximum amounts for both the Federal Pell Grant and Federal Direct Loans. If you are already receiving the maximum amount for Pell and Direct Loans, there will be no additional aid for the Winter Mini session.
- If the Financial Aid Office determines a student is not making satisfactory academic progress (SAP) after the Fall 2009 semester, students will be responsible for any charges.
