



2008-2009 International Student Application Checklists

Required Items

The following documents are required for admission. All items listed below must be received by the Office of International Programs prior to reviewing your application.

- HCCC Application for Admission.
- An Original or Official Bank Statement.
- Declaration of Finances.
- Official transcripts from all prior post-high schools, colleges or universities attended.
- Immunization Form. (Optional) If you cannot provide this information after your arrival, our campus Health Services will provide you with all the required shots: 2 MMR (US\$5.00 per shot), 1 Tuberculosis skin test (US\$5.00 per test. If you tested positive, you are required to go for a chest x-ray (around US\$150.00)) which you will be responsible for.
- International Student Transfer Questionnaire (only if you are transferring from a school within the U.S.)

HCCC does not conditionally admit students. We will not issue an acceptance letter until all documents have been received and an admission decision has been made. Make sure all of your documents are submitted well before the application deadline to ensure you have enough time to apply for your student visa.
