



Inclusive Early Childhood Education Inclusive Elementary Education Bachelor of Science

- Eligible students must have an Associate's degree in either Early Childhood Education or Childhood Education or 60 transferrable credits with required prerequisites.
- Upon graduation from the IECE program, students may be eligible for dual certification in Early Childhood Teacher Education and Special Education (Birth–2nd Grade)
- Upon graduation from the IEE program, students may be eligible for dual certification in Inclusive Elementary Education and Special Education (Grades 1st – 6th)
- This is a part-time program in which students can take eleven credits at most per semester. Evening courses are offered at Herkimer College, each one night per week, 5:30–8:30 p.m. A selection of online courses is available.
- Residency Requirement, State Education Department One designated course must be completed on the Cazenovia College campus. This course will be offered in a summer two-weekend format and housing is provided. Usually second summer of the program.
- Tuition at Herkimer and online \$250/credit hour.
