


Herkimer College Learning Outcomes Assessment Plan



- Assessment of CLOs results in data that determine how course objectives are met.
- PLOs are served by the assessment results from CLOs, which determine whether program goals are met. See program maps for alignment.
- ILOs are assessed by using assessment data from PLO and CLO assessment. Faculty identify course/ILO alignment.
- Continuing the improvement spiral on SLO assessment, includes modifications to goals, outcomes, methods, and teaching techniques that are informed by assessment of CLOs, PLOs and ILOs.
- Learning Activities Assessment was added to the assessment flow in 2013-2014, as all faculty were invited to choose one learning activity to assess, using the Teaching Goals Inventory as a guide for prioritizing expectations and helping to design appropriate, purposeful learning activities and assessments. While learning activities assessment remains optional for faculty, it is used by many as an improvement gauge and a best practice documentation.
