All you have to do is give us the details of the work you are looking for, and our staff will track down a copy and have it delivered here for your use. The same thing goes for articles, which can arrive even faster in some cases if you prefer to receive them by email.

Just click the link on the left side of the library homepage and log in with your regular Herkimer Information. On your first visit you'll need to provide some more information, so we can get your materials to you easier. Once you are logged in, you can fill out the form for a new request. While only three pieces of information are required (Title, Author and a deadline that you set), we will have a better shot at finding your request if you give us all the info you can. If you have found the book on a site like Amazon, or Google books, then try to find something like the ISBN number. That is an international standardized number that all published books have. It can make our search fast and accurate.

Once we have found your book, or article we will notify you by email, and you can pick up the material from the circulation desk at the library. The amount of time you can keep the book will vary slightly based on the preferences of the lending library.

Now, having books and other materials shipped here by land <u>takes time</u>. Do not come to the library the day before your paper is due and think that we can work a miracle to get you a book from the Alaska Public Library. For most materials you should plan on at least ten days to two weeks for processing and arrival. For articles which can be photocopied and emailed, it can be as quick as 3 days, but will more likely be a week at least. That can seem like a long time, but if you use this resource with proper time management then you will be very satisfied with the results.
