

Project SEARCH is an international trademarked and copyrighted intern program model that focuses solely on employment for young adults with disabilities. The local program is a collaboration between Career Connections, the employment division of the Arc Herkimer, and Herkimer County Community College in Herkimer, NY. The 40-week partnership has an intensive focus on achieving competitive employment and maximum independence for each participant. Each intern participates in daily classroom instruction and gains hands-on work experience by rotating among three unique unpaid internships throughout the academic year. Skills learned by the interns will be marketable in their search for community employment.

Key Program Components:

- Individuals apply through an application process.
- Project SEARCH Steering Committee reviews applications, interviews qualified applicants, and chooses 6 to 8 individuals for the internship program at Herkimer College.
- Applicants can be considered for other available services through the Career Connections Program.

Eligibility Criteria:

- 18-34 years old
- Documented developmental disability
- Willingness to learn and achieve excellent attendance
- Personal goal to become employed within the community at the end of Project SEARCH program

- Each intern will do 3 internships per year at Herkimer College and some work assessments within the community.
- Intern positions at the college are jobs that are complex and systematic giving individual's choice of various work experiences available at the college and in the community.
- Skills learned by interns need to be marketable as an outcome as a path to community employment.
