Herkimer offers non-credit courses in writing, grammar, reading, speaking and listening, and U.S. culture. ESL courses can help you develop your English skills in preparation for college courses. You may take ESL courses at the same time you are enrolled in courses in your major.

While non-credit courses do not count toward a degree, they help you prepare for credit-bearing courses that require competence in American English, and set you up for success beyond our degree programs.

24-Credit Option for High School Students

Herkimer offers a 24-credit-hour high school completion option for international students who are at least 17 years of age. After successfully completing 24 college credits in specific areas of study, you will earn a state high school equivalency diploma without having to take the equivalency examination.

Herkimer College's degree in Electrical Technology prepares students for careers in the design, application, installation, manufacturing, operation and/or maintenance of electrical/electronic(s) systems, with a focus on smart grid technologies. The program was created in partnership with Buffalo State University and the New York Power Authority. Our new two-million-dollar state-of-the-art electrical technology smart grid laboratory allows for hands-on experiments in generation, transmission, and distribution of electric power, as well as smart grid and renewable energy technologies.
