Transfer Articulation Agreement
Herkimer County Community College

Hilbert College and Herkimer County Community College through this formal articulation agreement, wish to strengthen their relationship and thereby assist students in their attainment of undergraduate degrees. This agreement should ensure student mobility within higher education, both public and private, across the State of New York. This agreement includes transfer into the Criminal Justice baccalaureate degree program offered at Hilbert College from the Criminal Justice: Forensic Investigation A.A.S, Criminal Justice A.A.S., Criminal Justice A.S. and Criminal Justice: Crime & Intelligence Analysis A.A.S. at Herkimer County Community College.

The agreement will be monitored on a yearly basis by contact among officials from each institution. Each party assumes responsibility for making this agreement a viable and workable alternative for interested students. Either party may carry out the publication and marketing of this agreement.

All students transferring to Hilbert College from Herkimer County Community College

- have a minimum of 2.20 in the major field of study;
- have a minimum cumulative quality point average of 2.00;
- have earned a "C" grade in all academic course-work as minimum level;
- have obtained the associate degree in the Herkimer County Community College Criminal Justice: Forensic Investigation A.A.S, Criminal Justice A.A.S., Criminal Justice A.S. or Criminal Justice: Crime & Intelligence Analysis A.A.S. program
- Exceptions shall be made on a case by case basis

Once accepted into Hilbert College, students who are transferring into BS degree in Criminal Justice from the Criminal Justice: Forensic Investigation A.A.S, Criminal Justice A.A.S., Criminal Justice A.S. or Criminal Justice: Crime & Intelligence Analysis A.A.S. Program will:

- be considered to receive a transfer articulation scholarship . The scholarship currently provides financial assistance in the amount of \$1,250 per semester of full-time enrollment for four consecutive semesters
- be advised by faculty within their academic departments as they pursue the successful completion of degree requirements. The enclosed program sheet outlines what courses a Herkimer County Community College Criminal Justice: Forensic Investigation A.A.S, Criminal Justice A.A.S., Criminal Justice A.S. or Criminal Justice: Crime & Intelligence Analysis A.A.S. graduate would have to complete at Hilbert College under optimal transfer conditions and is provided as a reference for

departmental advisors, Minor adjustments may be made on a case by case basis based on the individual's elective choices or after evaluating additional coursework taken beyond their degree.

- complete a minimum of forty-five upper-level credits at Hilbert College
- achieve grade point averages that are set forth to reflect successful completion of degree requirements,

This agreement contains program sheets specifying equivalencies of courses at Herkimer County Community College and those at Hilbert College, and illustrating those courses that incoming Herkimer County Community College Criminal Justice: Forensic Investigation A.A.S, Criminal Justice A.A.S., Criminal Justice A.S. or Criminal Justice: Crime & Intelligence Analysis A.A.S. graduates will have to complete in order to receive their baccalaureate degrees from Hilbert College.
