Purpose

The purpose of this agreement is to facilitate credit transfer and provide a smooth transition for students in the AS and AAS Accounting, AS and AAS Business Administration, AAS Human Resource Management, International Business, AAS Marketing, Computer Network Technician, Computer Support Specialist, AAS Small Business Management, and AAS Travel and Tourism Hospitality & Events Management at the Herkimer County Community College (HCCC) into the Bachelor of Business Administration in Entrepreneurship and Small Business Management at Morrisville State College (MSC).

Agreement

This agreement applies to transfer students who have completed the AS and AAS Accounting, AS and AAS Business Administration, AAS Human Resource Management, International Business, AAS Marketing, Computer Network Technician, Computer Support Specialist, AAS Small Business Management, and AAS Travel and Tourism Hospitality & Events Management at the Herkimer County Community College and received an Associate of Science or Associate of Applied Science degree program and who followed the prescribed outline of courses.

This agreement lists all courses, which may transfer to the BBA in Entrepreneurship and Small Business Management at Morrisville State College from the Herkimer County Community College and indicates which ones fulfill specific requirements. Program-specific.requirements and/or required courses are listed for both institutions in Appendix A.

The evaluation and transfer of earned college credits will be in full compliance with MSC policies and all other state and Federal education policies pertaining to undergraduate credit transfer. Only grades of "C" and better will be considered acceptable for transfer to Morrisville State College. Grades of "C-"or lower are not acceptable for transfer credit evaluation.

Official credit evaluation will be completed only after acceptance into Morrisville State College.

APPENDIX A: Articulation Guide

Admissions Requirements

Students transferring into Morrisville State College must have attained an overall GPA of 2.3, Math 130, and a minimum of 60 credit hours or an Associate Degree and submit SUNY application as well as high school and college transcripts plus the BBA in Entrepreneurship and Small Business Management Application for review by Morrisville State College Admissions Office.

College Graduation Requirements

Please refer to Appendix A for degree and specific SUNY General Education requirements (30 credit hours). Transferring students will be required to complete a minimum of 49 credit hours in upper division coursework at Morrisville State College. A minimum of 121 credit hours must be earned and a 2.0 minimum GPA is required for graduation.

Articulation Implementation and Agreement Review

Responsibility for oversight of this agreement rests with the Counselor-Transfer Services at Herkimer County Community College. One administrative or faculty member from each institution will be appointed to act as agents responsible for implementing this agreement; identifying and incorporating any changes into subsequent agreements; communicating changes to perspective faculty members, advisors, counselors, and others to whom the information is pertinent; and for conducting a periodic review of this agreement.

This agreement becomes effective on December 2011, and remains in effect until December 2016.
